EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCE (EC)

An upheld Extenuating Circumstance serves the purpose of giving the students an opportunity to take the examination as a first attempt instead of being considered a re-sit.

- Those whose extenuating circumstance (EC) claims are upheld will be allowed to take the respective module papers with a RM 100 per component. The maximum grade that can be obtained by a candidate whose EC is upheld is a Distinction.
- Those whose Extenuating Circumstance (EC) claims are rejected for lack of evidence or because the circumstance leading to the claim is not classified as an extenuating circumstance will have to retake module with attendance or take a re-sit paper as per EC Board Decision. The maximum grade that can be obtained by a candidate whose EC is not upheld is a pass.
