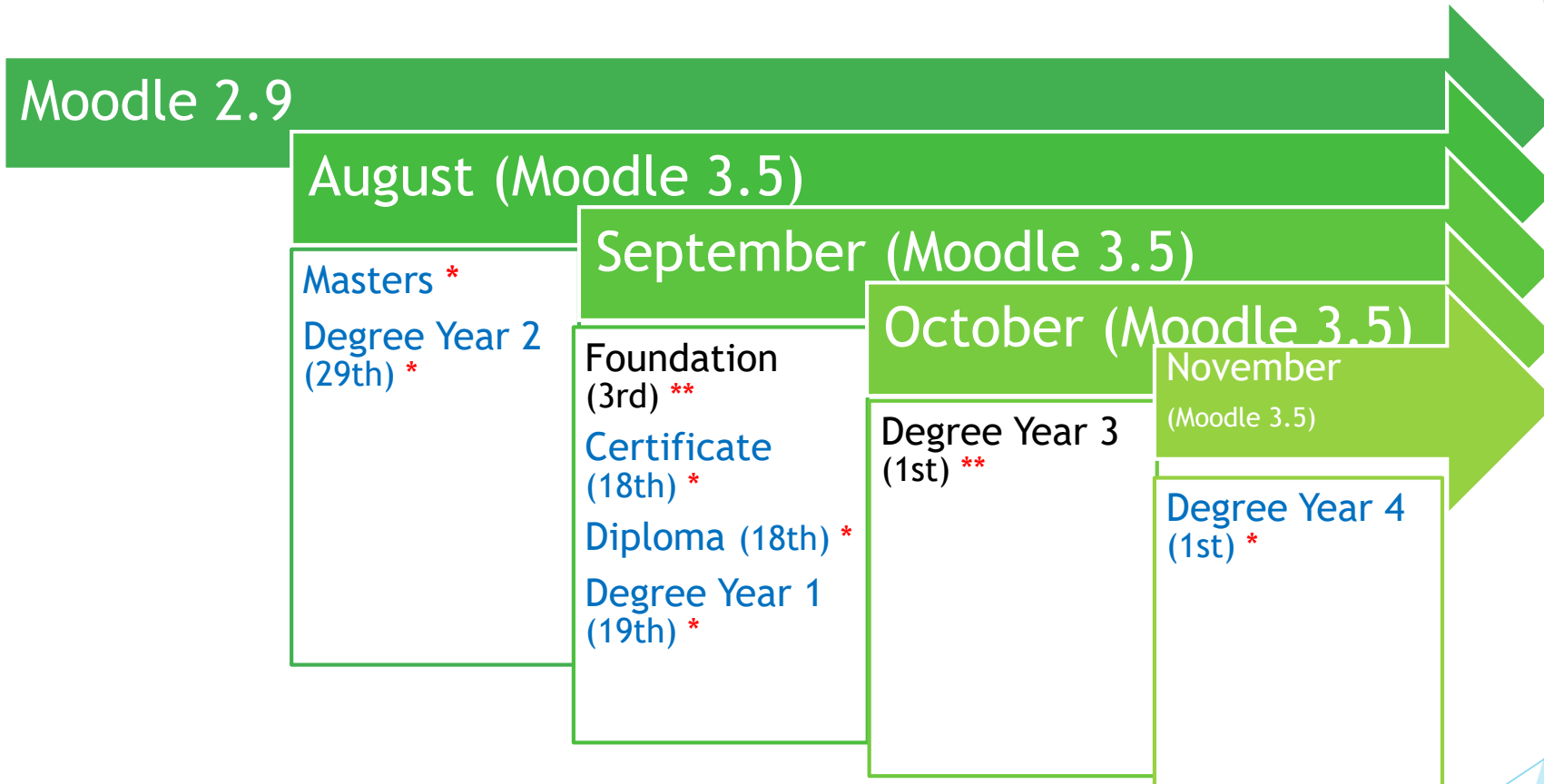



- ▶ Upgraded Moodle can be accessed from Webspaces by clicking on “Access Course Material” banner. Then click “Moodle version 3.5”



- ▶ Key in your APKey and password (email username and password) and click on “LOGIN” button.
- ▶ “I’m not a robot” must be ticked before “Login” is being clicked

- ▶ **Course Overview / Dashboard page:** better usability for dashboard page and course overview with easy navigation between modules.
- ▶ **Module listed based on class duration:**
 - ▶ **In progress:** list of current classes
 - ▶ **Future:** list of upcoming classes
 - ▶ **Past:** view past classes according to the end date.
 - ▶ **Note:** the intake specific links will be accessible until six months after class end date.

New Features

▶ Dashboard: Completion tracking

- ▶ If enabled, activity completion is tracked, either manually or automatically, based on certain conditions. Multiple conditions may be set if desired. If so, the activity will only be considered complete when ALL conditions are met.
- ▶ A tick next to the activity name on the course page indicates when the activity is complete.
